



Preseason Checklist

1. Inspect all decals they must be in place and legible prior to operating the leaf vacuum.
2. Check all guards to ensure they are undamaged, in place and properly secured.
3. Inspect the leaf vacuum frame and structure for any bent, broken, cracked, missing or loose parts.
4. Inspect the impeller fan blades for bent or cracked blades (replace fan if any damage is present).
5. Inspect the liner in the blower housing for wear and cracks.
6. Inspect the blower intake and exhaust hoses for wear and hose clamps.
7. Inspect blower gasket and adjustment on dump units.
8. Inspect all boom mounts and pin connections for wear.
9. Lubricate impeller shaft flange bearings (if equipped) **DO NOT OVER GREASE THESE BEARINGS** see manual for proper grease.
10. Check all fluid levels, engine oil, radiator coolant and antifreeze strength, Hyd. fluid, swing gear box, differential axle and axles on trailer mounted units some may be grease able.
11. Check power band belt for tension, cracks in the belt and burn marks, also check pulley sheaves.
12. Check clutch / PTO linkage adjustment (see manual for proper adjustment)
13. Inspect leaf box screens that they are clean and mount correctly in place.
14. Inspect radiator fins for debris in fins and screens, clean if needed.
15. Inspect battery connections and battery disconnect switch.
16. Check wheel lug nuts and tire pressures / tire condition.
17. Trailer units check hitch, safety chains, brakes and break-away switch.
18. Inspect air cleaner filters and pre-cleaners.
19. Inspect all door hinges and dump body hinges for cracks and loose keepers on pins, also grease them if needed.
20. Run unit and check for vibration.
21. Check all gauges and switches to make sure there functioning properly.
22. Check all running lights, beacon and work lights.
23. If equipped with DEF check the quality of the DEF and fluid level.
24. Test boom controls that they are working properly.
25. Check the hours on unit and see which service interval you're at for maintenance. (see manual for intervals).
26. Inspect rear door seals on hopper.
27. Check fuel tanks for leaks and fuel lines for leaks.
28. Inspect Hyd. hoses and radiator hoses for wear and leaks.
